3. NOTES RELATED TO MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT

- (i) Candidate shall be admitted in a course according to merit drawn on the basis of aggregate marks secured in the Entrance Test provided he/she fulfills the minimum eligibility criteria and minimum qualifying marks in the Entrance Test.
- (ii) Candidates appearing in the Final Year of the Qualifying Examination may also apply and appear in the Test. However, the candidate will be required to produce the original mark sheet of the qualifying examination at the time of provisional admission.

However, the admission can be allowed on the condition that:

Such candidates should give an undertaking that they will produce the original mark sheet of the qualifying examination with minimum eligibility requirement within fortnight of provisional admission.

(iii). If the applicant has passed the qualifying exam where grades are awarded and:

(a) Where the Grade Sheet does not mention the equivalent percentage of marks from grade points, the candidate should submit such a Certificate of conversion from the concerned Institution mentioning either the converted percentage, or the formula for the actual conversion of grade point average to percentage of marks;

(b) Where the Grade Sheet itself mentions the equivalent percentage of marks from grade points, or the formula for such conversion, the candidate should get both sides of the Degree/Grade Sheet photocopied showing the equivalent percentage of marks/conversion formula.

(a) to (d) including deaf-blindness in the posts identified for each disabilities: (1%) (on horizontal reservation basis). Such candidates will have to submit a self-attested copy of Disability Certificate issued by the District CMO/ Civil Surgeon/ Medical Superintendent of a Government Health Care Institution with the Application Form.

Candidates who request the University for providing Scribe shall be allotted a Entrance Test Centre in the University Campus, Jamuhar, Sasaram only.

Note:

“Compensatory time” @ of 20 minutes per hour of examination for persons who are allowed use of scribe would be provided. All the candidates with benchmark disability not availing the facility of scribe would also be allowed additional time @ of 20 minutes per hour of examination. The Physically Challenged candidates called for provisional admission will be examined by a Medical Board of the Gopal Narayan Singh University, if necessary.

The decision of the Medical Board constituted by GNSU will be final.

6. INSTITUTIONAL PREFERENCE:

Institutional preference will be given to graduate passed out from the Gopal Narayan Singh University against 25% out of the total seats prescribed for that particular discipline.

7. APPLICATION PROCESSING/ENTRANCE TEST FEE

The Candidate shall pay the following Entrance Test fee:

Entrance Test Fee for all courses except Nursing	Rs. 500.00
For Nursing	Rs.1000.00

In case a candidate prefers to be considered for more than one course for which there are separate/common entrance tests, he/ she shall apply for each such course separately (See schedule of Entrance Tests). However, in case the candidate makes application (fills up application form) for more than one course under University Entrance Test- 2023, the Application Processing Fee/Entrance Test Fee payable by him/her for each subsequent application (after first application).

Mode of Payment of Application Processing/Entrance Test Fee Candidate is required to fill up the Entrance Test Application Form ONLINE. After the candidate has filled up the application form online, he/she will have following options for payment of Application Processing/Entrance Test Fee:

- Online payment through credit card/ debit card through the payment gateway available on the Entrance Test portal.
- Payment of Entrance Test Fee in Cash through “Challan” in any branch of **HDFC Bank**.

8. University Entrance Tests for admission to all programme will be held in the Campus of the Gopal Narayan Singh University or at other centers as decided by the University from time to time (if any).

9. Dates for Offline/Online University Entrance Test will be communicated later on.

10. ADMISSION OF FOREIGN NATIONALS

Foreign Nationals:

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1. The prescribed application form of ICCR available at the Indian embassy in their respective country to be filled up and submitted along with all the necessary documents, certificates etc.
2. If admission and scholarship is offered to them, they get the information from the Indian Embassy in their country.
3. They should get proper **Student's Visa, endorsed in the name of Gopal Narayan Singh University** from the embassy.
4. On acquiring the Student Visa, the candidate has to report for admission to the department concerned of the Gopal Narayan Singh University within the period prescribed in the provisional admission letter.
5. The admission of International students will be confirmed only after verification of original certificates, medical fitness test, Student Visa and payment of required fees.
