

The Anti-Ragging Committee

The University Grants Commission (UGC) as well as Bar Council of India (BCI) has reiterated a strict ban on ragging in institutions of higher education. All students admitted to the Narayan School of Law, Gopal Narayan Singh University are hereby directed to strictly refrain from engaging in any form of ragging within or outside the campus premises.

Forms of Ragging

Display of noisy, disorderly conduct, teasing, excitement by rough or rude treatment or handling, including rowdy, undisciplined activities which cause or likely to cause annoyance, undue hardship, physical or psychological harm or raise apprehensive fear in a fresher, or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such a student will not do in the ordinary course and which causes him/her shame or embarrassment or danger to his/her life, etc.

Punishment for Participation in/or Abetment of Ragging

Following Punishment may be given to the learners for Participation in/or Abetment of Ragging:

1. Cancellation of admission from the college.
2. Suspension from attending lectures and practicals.
3. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
4. Debarring from appearing in any Internal /semester end examination or other evaluation process.
5. Withholding results of Internal /semester end examination of the college.
6. Debarring from representing the college in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
7. Suspension/expulsion from the college hostel.
8. Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4 semesters or equivalent period.
9. Expulsion from the college and consequent debarring from admission to any other college/institution.
10. Fine up to Rs. 25,000/-

6. To hold periodic meetings and submit reports to the University authorities.

Complaint Mechanism:

Any complaint of ragging may be submitted in writing, through email, or reported telephonically to any member of the Committee. Upon receipt of a complaint, the Committee shall promptly conduct a preliminary inquiry and take immediate necessary action, including informing the competent authorities, as per UGC norms.

All members shall perform their duties with utmost responsibility and commitment to maintaining a ragging-free campus.
