Call for Paper/Poster Presentation:

You are all invited to submit abstract (250-300 words) of your scientific endeavors for oral/poster presentations to the conference mail id pharmaanveshanbihar@gnsu.ac.in before 25th February 2026.

Ensure that the submission follows the prescribed guidelines and clearly mentions the preferred presentation type (Oral/Poster).

1. Abstract should be typed in MS word format (Times New Roman, font size 12, 1.5 line spacing) with capital and bold faces title and headings. Presenting authors name should be bold.

2. Abstract from registered participants will be entertained.

Guidelines for Oral Presentation

- Selected abstracts will be allotted 8 minutes for presentation + 2 minutes for discussion.
- Presentation must be prepared in PowerPoint (PPT).
- Content should be clear, scientific, and within the allotted time. Presenter must be present at the venue as per the schedule.

Guidelines for Poster Presentation

- Poster size: Standard A0 (84.1 cm × 118.9 cm), Portrait orientation.
- Poster should include Title, Authors, Affiliation, Introduction, Methodology, Results, Conclusion, References, and Acknowledgement.
- Use clear headings, readable fonts, and appropriate figures/graphs.
- Presenter must be available near the poster during the evaluation session.
