#### SDCA-03: Soil testing 3.

**Total Hours: 30** 

Course Objectives: The basic objective of the soil-testing program is to give farmers a service leading to better and more economic use of fertilizers and better soil management practices for increasing agricultural production.

# Course Outcome:

- 1. Collect samples from agricultural fields and prepare samples for soil testing following safety precautions.
- 2. Perform soil testing to identify the different components in the soil.
- 3. Calculate nutrients from different fertilizer sources, recommend appropriate fertilizer, quantum of dose and distribution of fertilizer based on the soil properties.
- 4. Perform application of fertilizers for various crops.

## Syllabus -

#### Unit I

Introduction to Soil Formation, Types of Soils & Basic Concepts about Physical, chemical, and biological properties of different soil types; Identification of nutrient deficiency Symptoms in Crops & Fertilizer recommendations

Introductory remarks about various soil testing methods and the Importance of Soil Testing and Analyses

#### Unit II

Criteria for selection of field, Method of Soil Sample collection, Methods of soil sample processing, Precautions during soil collection & processing, Preservation, labeling and Storage of soil samples.

Study of Laboratory Setup, Laboratory Layout, built up area, Laboratory requirements and working pattern of a soil testing Lab.

### Unit III

Study of Instruments: Brief study of instruments: pH Meter, Conductivity meter, spectrometer, UV-Spectrophotometer, (Calibration, Instrumentation, applications only) use of soil testing kits etc.; Kjeldahl's Assembly for determination of nitrogen.

### Unit IV

Determination of pH & Electrical Conductivity of Soil Samples using pH/Electrical Conductivity meter; Determination of Organic Carbon; Total & available Nitrogen, Phosphorus, Potassium & micronutrients from soil samples.

Determination of lime requirement of soil; Determination of Gypsum requirement of Soil Preparation of Soil analysis and test report; Preparation of soil test summaries and fertility maps.

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
